- ▶ Please do not let children stand on railings and fences.
- ▶ Photography is welcome, but no selfie sticks. Please stay safely behind barriers and only in public areas.
- ▶ Please no smoking. The entire Zoo (including the parking lot) is a non-smoking facility.
- ▶ Please do not pick flowers, uproot trees and shrubs, or strip branches or leaves.
