

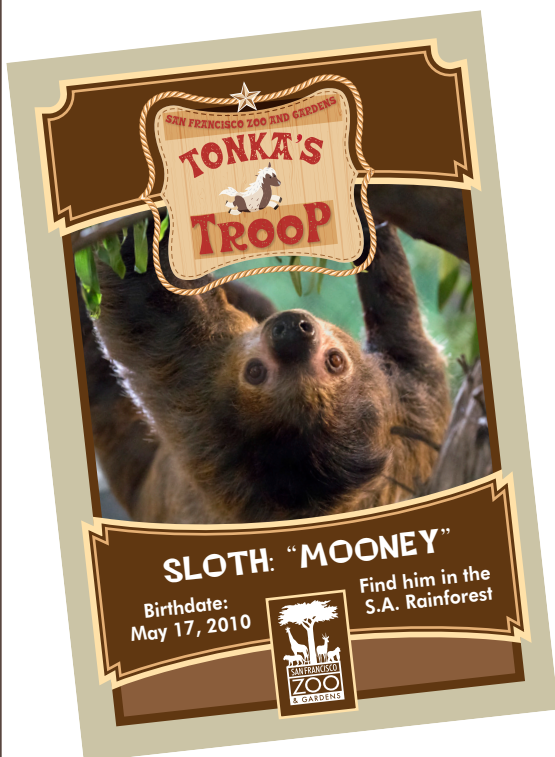

At 7-years-old, Pookie is a pretty active, curious sloth. He immediately checks out anything new in his exhibit and loves to take baths. Pookie is very food-motivated and not very picky though his favorites include nuts, fruit, endive, and lettuces. His favorite enrichment includes hanging log feeders and forage boards, hammocks and fresh edible browse.

Mooney, 11, is a shy, sweet-tempered sloth who takes life very slow. When the sun hits the top of his exhibit through the skylight next to it, he likes to climb up onto the mesh and sunbathe. He is not a big fan of greens and veggies, but he has a big sweet tooth. His favorite enrichment includes log feeders and forage boards, and boxes.

Sloths have a large, four-chambered stomach, like a cow. Bacteria in their gut help digest the large amount of plant matter they eat.

Sloths actually only sleep for an average of 8-10 hours.

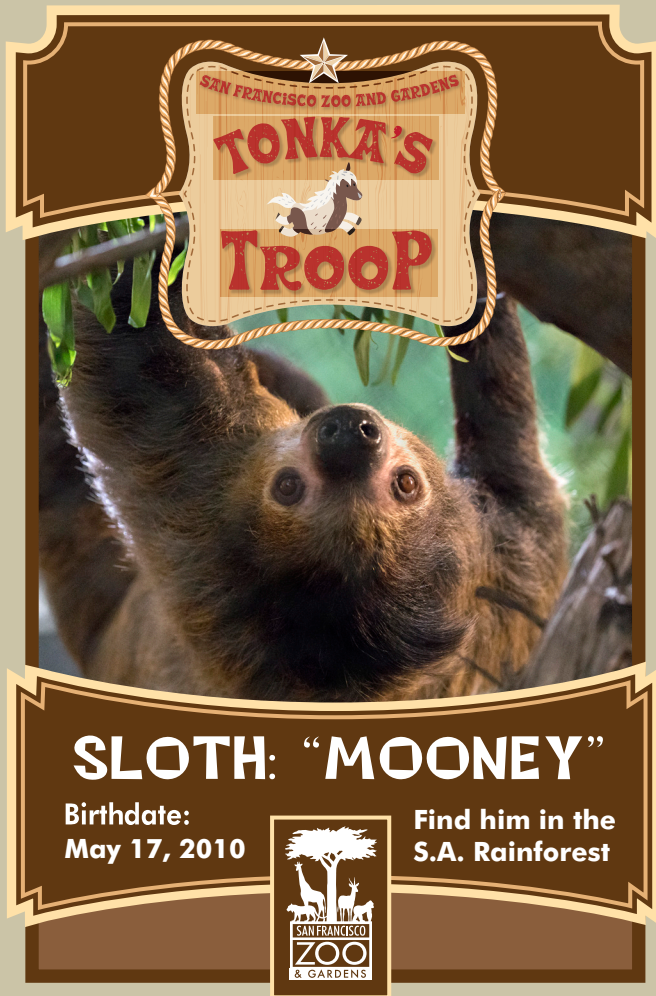
QUICK CHUCKLES
