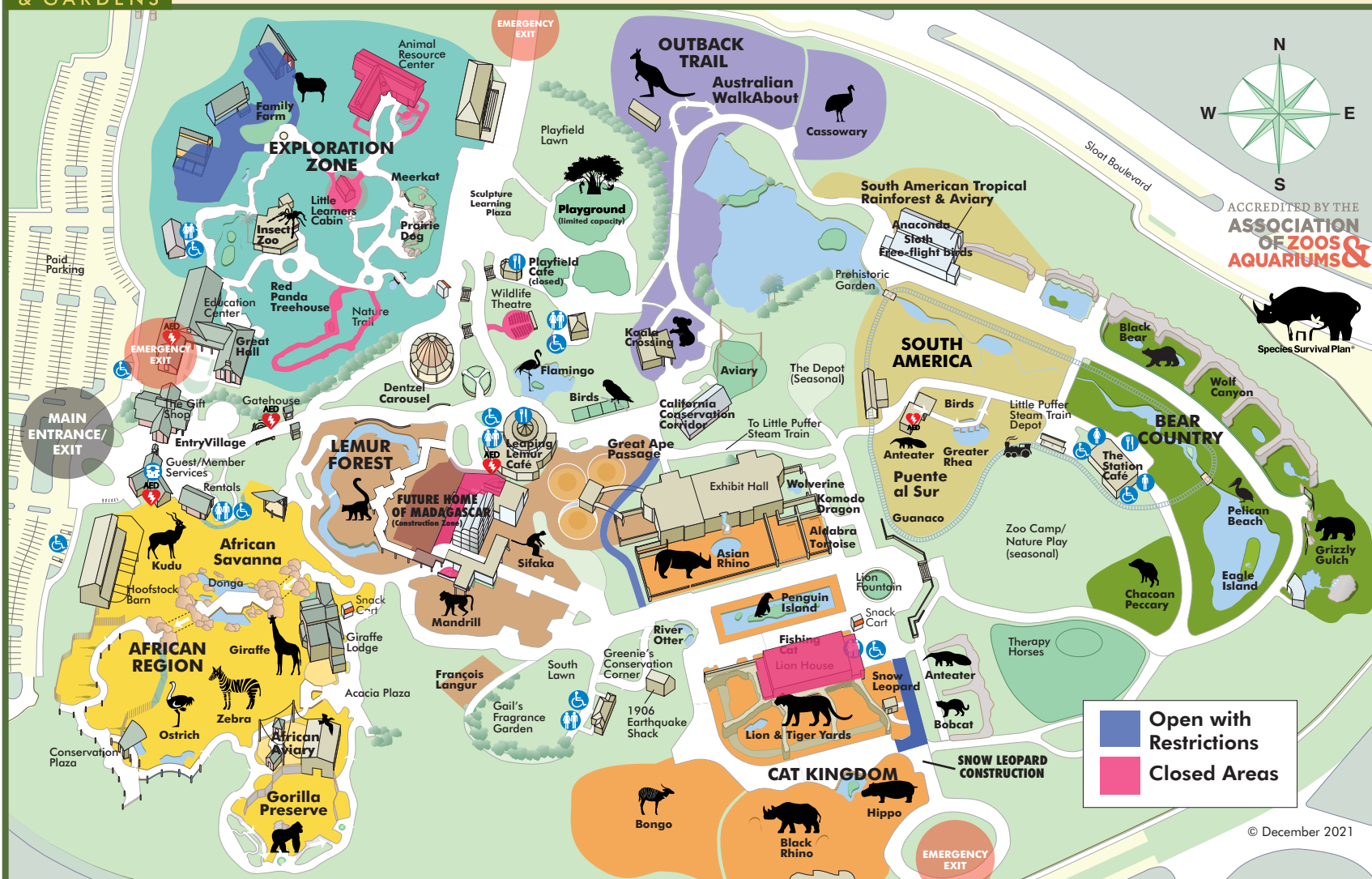


# VISITOR GUIDE
