

ENROLLMENT POLICY

- Children must be at least 5 years old, fully vaccinated, and should be registered for the grade level they will be entering in the 2022-2023 school year.
- Registration for Zoo Camp 2022 is online at www.sfzoo.org/zoocamp
- Registration begins April 20, 2022 at 11 am.
- Sessions will automatically close when they reach capacity. Additional registrants may place themselves on a waitlist.
- We reserve the right to dismiss any camper without refund for behavior we determine to be detrimental to the camp or to themselves.
- Summer programs operate rain or shine.

ZOO CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded to qualifying families through a lottery system.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The San Francisco Zoo & Gardens is thrilled to be able to offer a safe atmosphere for your child to learn and grow.

We have adapted the program to meet SF Department of Public Health directives and will continue to modify protocols as recommendations evolve. Below are a few examples that illustrate our commitment to safety.

Staff, campers and volunteers will be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and participate in daily health screenings.

Face coverings are required for all camp participants, volunteers and staff.

Camp will take place primarily outdoors; when indoors for short periods of time, spaces will be well ventilated.

As always, regular handwashing and sanitizing will occur throughout the day.

VACCINATION POLICY

All camp participants must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and present proof of vaccination prior to the start of Zoo Camp.

Campers are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after completing primary vaccination, with, if applicable, at least the recommended interval between doses. For example, 2 weeks after a second dose in a two-dose series or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine.

Acceptable proof includes a physical, digital copy or picture of a CDC vaccination card, documentation from a health care provider or a digital COVID-19 vaccine record issued by the State of California.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

We strive to provide an inclusive environment for all campers; lessons and activities are age-appropriate and designed for multiple learning styles. Zoo Camp staff are able to make activity modifications and appropriate accommodations for campers with special needs. The Zoo is wheelchair accessible and a limited number of wheelchairs are available for Zoo Camp's use. If your child has a one-to-one aide in school, you will be required to provide one pre-approved, certified aide for Zoo Camp as well. Please call (415) 213-8148 or email zoocamp@sfzoo.org to discuss your child's needs prior to registration.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be received in writing by email.

A 100% refund will be issued for cancellation requests received within 24 hours of registration. The timestamp on your email will serve as reference for potential refunds.

A 75% refund will be issued for cancellations received more than 7 days in advance of the event. The non-refundable 25% will be forfeited completely and is non-transferable.

No refunds will be issued for cancellations within 7 days of the event. No refunds or transfers will be issued for missed days.

The Zoo has the right to cancel duplicate registrations at any time without notice; please do not register for more than one week of each theme. No refunds or transfers will be issued, but you may elect to receive credit for later us.

There is a \$25 fee to transfer more than 24 hours after registering, if a spot is available The timestamp on your request email will serve as a reference for potentially waiving this fee

Cancellation policy also applies to scholarship recipients.

These policies hold for instances of illness and family emergencies.
